THE PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION WITH THE COLLEAGUES & KNOWLEDGE TO HELP

The association consists of persons who are currently working in local authority posts which impact on any of the licensing functions. Members may be clerks, technical assistants, licensing and enforcement officers or Solicitors and Legal Executives. In addition there are a number of honorary members who, due to their years of experience in this field, also contribute greatly to the strength of the Association.

Current Members (in excess of 590+) include officers from the Eire Taxi Commissioners staff, the Northern Ireland Department of the Environment, The Isle of Man Road Transport Commission, The Channel Islands, The Public Carriage Office in London and numerous local authorities throughout England, Wales and Scotland.

All fully paid up members have access to our website at <http://cms.naleo.org.uk> (a non-members area can be browsed before joining) and this website also hosts a member's forum which allows your problems to be posted and you to receive/ browse answers directly. (When your membership card arrives, details of login and password are provided and you may alter your details on the site directly). Members can also post questions via the National Secretary. This results in a round robin email to all members. This quickly assists officers not to have to reinvent the wheel!

The Association is divided into six regions, which hold usually six monthly meetings to discuss matters of interest. In addition in October of each year there is a National Seminar and Annual General Meeting. All members receive two (sometimes three) copies of a licensing bulletin each year again containing licensing updates and news.

The Association has available the 14th edition of Bryan Denby's Licensing Guide "The Book on CD" in a fully- searchable adobe pdf format at a cost of £45-00. This contains a Taxi & Private Hire Licensing guide, 160+ full case transcripts together with relevant Statutes, statutory Instruments, Central Government Guides and Government Circulars and other relevant material.

In January 2010 there will as usual be a three- day training course held in Daventry which is split into 5 separate modules. Any two of these modules can form the basis of an Edexcel-accredited BTEC in Taxi Licensing (3 levels available). General Licensing training and BTEC are also available. Tutors on the courses can provide a wealth of experience in PACE, Driving Licence Recognition, Self defence and awareness and many other fields. Attendees regularly remark on how accessible the tutors are even after the courses have finished.
